To apply for a graduate position at BCH:

All applicants must be registered through **Computer Match** for first round offers.

Applications open Monday July 13th and close Monday 3rd of August 2020

All applications must include the following:

- A one page **Cover Letter** outlining why you have selected Bass Coast Health for your Graduate Year. Cover letter must include your computer match **candidate number** and **two areas of clinical interest**.
- A **Resume** containing your contact details, employment history and list of clinical placements.
- A certified copy of your most recent **academic transcript** with a key to results.
- Two certified copies of your two most recent **clinical summative appraisals**. BCH is able to accept one second year clinical appraisal if necessary.
- Two clinical references** who can describe your Nursing practice. Please consider the following when selecting your referees:
A referee must be a person who has worked directly with you on clinical placement such as an **Educator, Preceptor or a Senior Nurse**. Ideally referees should be from your final undergraduate year and different placements.
References should be from a **Registered Nurse** not an Enrolled Nurse. Please ensure that **accurate and current phone and email** details are provided for each referee.
- Current certified **Police check**
- Current certified **Working with Children's check**.



Individual **interviews** will be conducted from the 10th August– 25st of September.

All successful applicants will be notified by BCH via telephone or email on Monday October 19th when computer match results become available.
